Golf Buggy Hire Agreement and Conditions of Hire

I (the hirer) confirm that I, and any other driver of this buggy within my playing group, are over 18 years old and are fully conversant with the correct and safe operation of a golf buggy.

I agree that during the period of my hire, I am personally responsible for any and all costs (excluding fair wear and tear) or claims arising out of damage or injury caused to the golf buggy, a third party, or any property, and for any injury sustained by the hirer. If in any doubt, the hirer is advised to obtain appropriate insurance cover for the period of hire.

Castle Douglas Golf Club will not accept any liability or responsibility for any injury or damage sustained or caused by the driver during the period of hire.

I accept that the buggy should be driven carefully and responsibly at all times. I will not consume or be under the influence of alcohol during my period of hire.

It is prohibited to drive the buggy across tees, greens and steep slopes.

At all times, all users must follow Club guidance regarding areas of the course that should be avoided. Do not drive buggies through trees or rough areas.

I will not use aggressive braking on the fairways. An automatic parking brake is fitted to most modern buggies. Please ensure this has engaged when leaving the buggy unattended. Where a manual parking brake is fitted, this should be engaged before leaving the buggy

Do not drive the buggy near or on the edge of any bunkers or water hazards on the course.

The buggies may only carry a maximum of two persons and two golf bags.

Failure to comply with these conditions of hire, may lead to the hirer and his/her playing partners, being asked to leave the course.

By signing this form, you have understood and agree to all the conditions above which are applicable when hiring a buggy.
